



***What to bring...***

Campers should pack clothes for warm weather and cool evenings. Bring along a "book bag" style shoulder pack for carrying things around camp, don't forget your sleeping bag, pillow and pillow case, towel, washcloth, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, pen and pencil, notebook, flashlight, bug spray, walking shoes, socks, sunscreen, bathing suit, and a white T-shirt for tie-dyeing.
